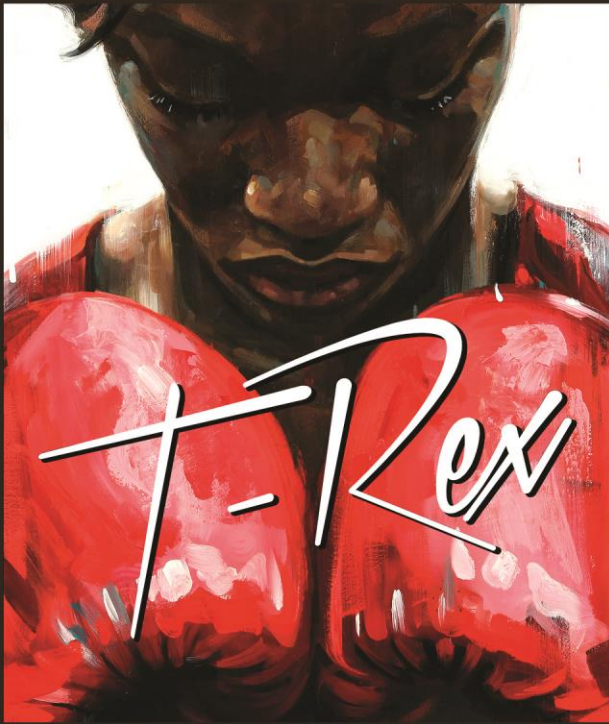


INDIE LENS **POP. UP** FREE FILM SCREENING
